



Role Description: CGNA Director Representing Conjoint Provincial Nursing Associations

The Board of Directors manages and supervises the management of the activities and affairs of CGNA. Directors representing conjoint provincial gerontological nursing associations are nominated by the executive or board of directors of their provincial gerontological nursing association. They provide regular and timely communication between the executive or board of directors of their provincial association and the Board of Directors. Directors participate in Board and CGNA committees. Directors attend quarterly teleconference meetings and biennial face-to-face meetings of the Board.
