The Clinical Coordinator coordinates client-care activities for three programs: 17-bed in-patient unit, day hospital, and **HomeVIVE** outreach. Our clients are seniors who have complex medical and mental health disorders. The Coordinator is responsible for client-flow and the day to day supervision of 45 staff on an interdisciplinary team.

About Us: Short Term Assessment & Treatment (STAT) Centre is a specialized unit for seniors experiencing health changes that interfere with functioning and independence. Services are provided by an interdisciplinary team with a holistic approach to client-centred care. Our interdisciplinary team carries out the assessment and treatment in collaboration with the client, family physician and other health professionals. Our goal is to improve quality of life by enhancing physical and mental health, functional abilities and independence.

Our clients are GENERALLY provided with:

- * A comprehensive medical and functional assessment
- * Treatment for illness
- * Strategies for coping with disabilities
- * Education regarding aging and health promotion
- * A therapeutic activity program
- * A general rehabilitative program
- * Assistance to continue living at home

HomeVIVE (Visiting Vancouver's Elders) assists with preventing hospitalization and residential placement for the elders including especially frail people. Our objective is to keep elders out of acute and long-term facilities, and with significantly strengthened staffing and resources, comprising of three family physicians and a nurse case manager visiting people at home.

Current Staffing: 10 MD's, 2 NP, 3 RN, 1.5 Physios, 1 OT, 2 Rehab Assistants.

Mandate/eligibility:

HomeVIVE is a basis on which a real comprehensive full-time primary care practice for frail people at home can be built. 80+ years of age, Frail (Clinical Frailty Scale of >6 moderately frail) Home bound and unable to access conventional primary care in an office/ clinic setting Clients whose complex needs exceed what usual care can be provided by the community Patient's GP unable to do home visits

Mandate provides an enhanced level of care in the home to allow seniors to avoid unnecessary acute care admission and residential care.
